On May 7, 2015, the Board directed staff to provide monthly reports of the District's water use, water savings projects, and activities to date.

Water Use

Attached is the monthly water use report, including:

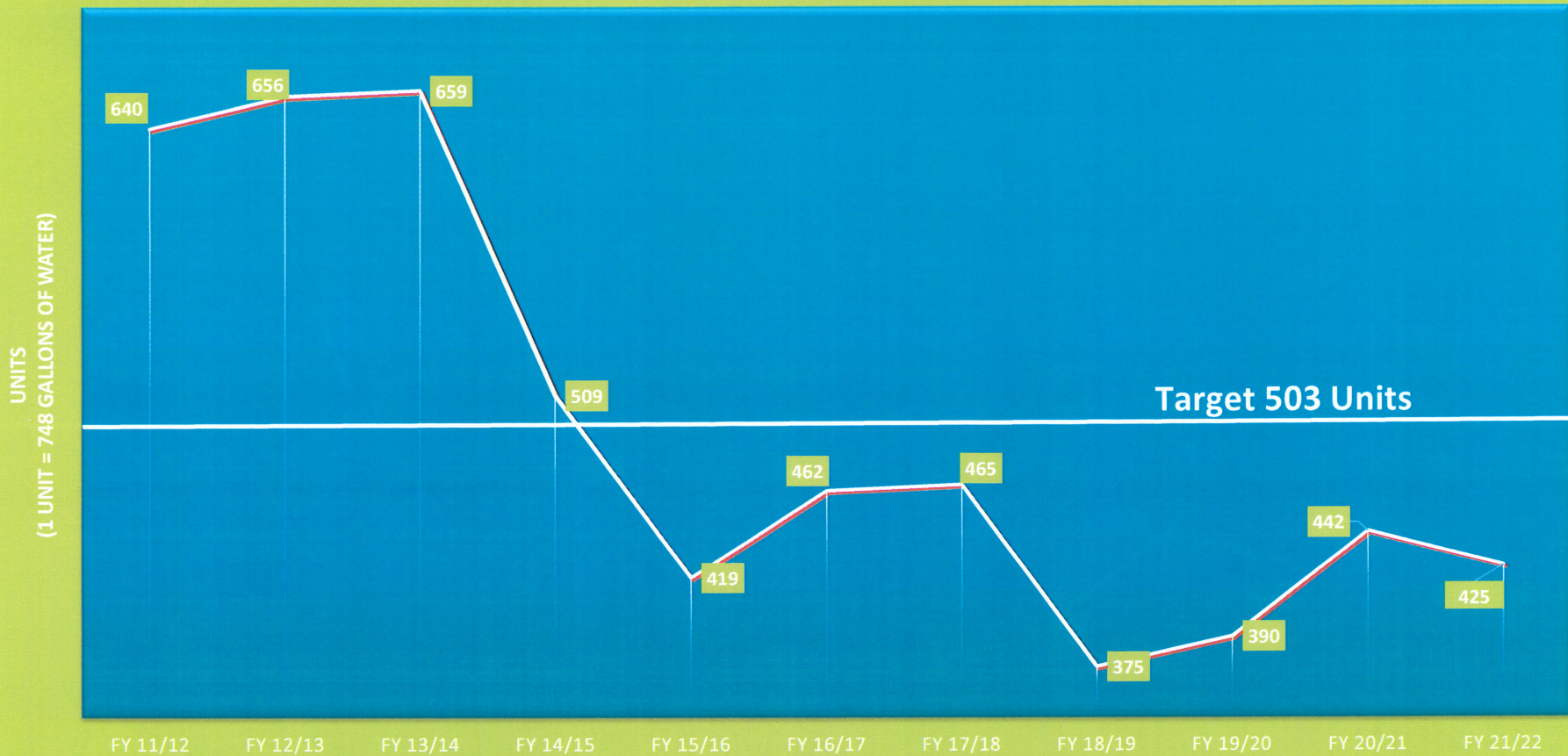
- Water Usage per Acre (All Funds) from Fiscal Year 2011/2012 to Fiscal Year 2021/2022 (to date and projected),
- Historical Water Usage (All Funds) for the month of June from Fiscal Year 2011/2022 to Fiscal Year 2021/2022
- Historical Water Usage (All Funds) from Fiscal Year 2011/2012 to Fiscal Year 2021/2022 (to date and projected),
- Overall Water Costs (All Funds) from Fiscal Year 2011/2012 to Fiscal Year 2021/2022 (to date and projected),
- Rainfall to date from Fiscal Year 2010/2011 to Fiscal Year 2021/2022 (to date).

FY 2021/2022 Water Savings Projects and Activities

- Capital and Major Repair Projects
 - Annual Drought Response Irrigation Improvements – Districtwide
 - ◆ Lynn Oaks Neighborhood Park, Dos Vientos Community Park - work completed September 2021

- ◆ Old Meadows Neighborhood Park – work completed November 2021
- ◆ Oakbrook Neighborhood Park – work completed January 2022
- ◆ Borchard Community Park – work estimated to be completed July 2022
- ◆ Thousand Oaks Community Park, Dos Vientos Community Park, Wildflower Playfield, Rancho Conejo Playfield, Conejo Community Park, Northwood Neighborhood Park, Evenstar Neighborhood Park, Sycamore Neighborhood Park, Newbury Gateway Park (completed June 2022); North Ranch Neighborhood Park (July 2022) – irrigation turned off in select areas (approximately 2.92 acres), turf conversions/beautifications on going
- ◆ Additional irrigation/turf conversions/beautifications at various parks – implementation Fiscal Year 2022/2023.
- Paige Lane Neighborhood Park Development
 - ◆ Directed Contractor to complete the park as approved for partial completion in Summer 2022 with landscaping - shrubs and tree plantings, but not including turf
 - ◆ Mulch all turf areas to keep park in a clean and dust free condition
 - ◆ Turf to be installed Spring 2023 dependent on drought conditions
- Annual Fertigation Tank Installations – Districtwide
 - ◆ Dos Vientos Community Park and Del Prado Playfield – work completed May 2022
- Modifying Turf Refurbishments
 - Ongoing
- Public Outreach
 - Board reviewed and approved the annual update report on the District’s Water Conservation Plan – October 21, 2021
 - Board reviewed and approved additional drought response guidelines to the District’s Water Conservation Plan – March 3, 2022
 - On behalf of the Board, Chair Cusworth sent letter to Metropolitan Water District of Southern California and Calleguas Municipal Water District considering the essentiality of public parks when crafting proposed water-use restrictions – April 21, 2022
 - Website updated - information, maps of turf conversion areas (www.crpd.org/water)
 - Signage regarding CRPD water conservation efforts placed at every park

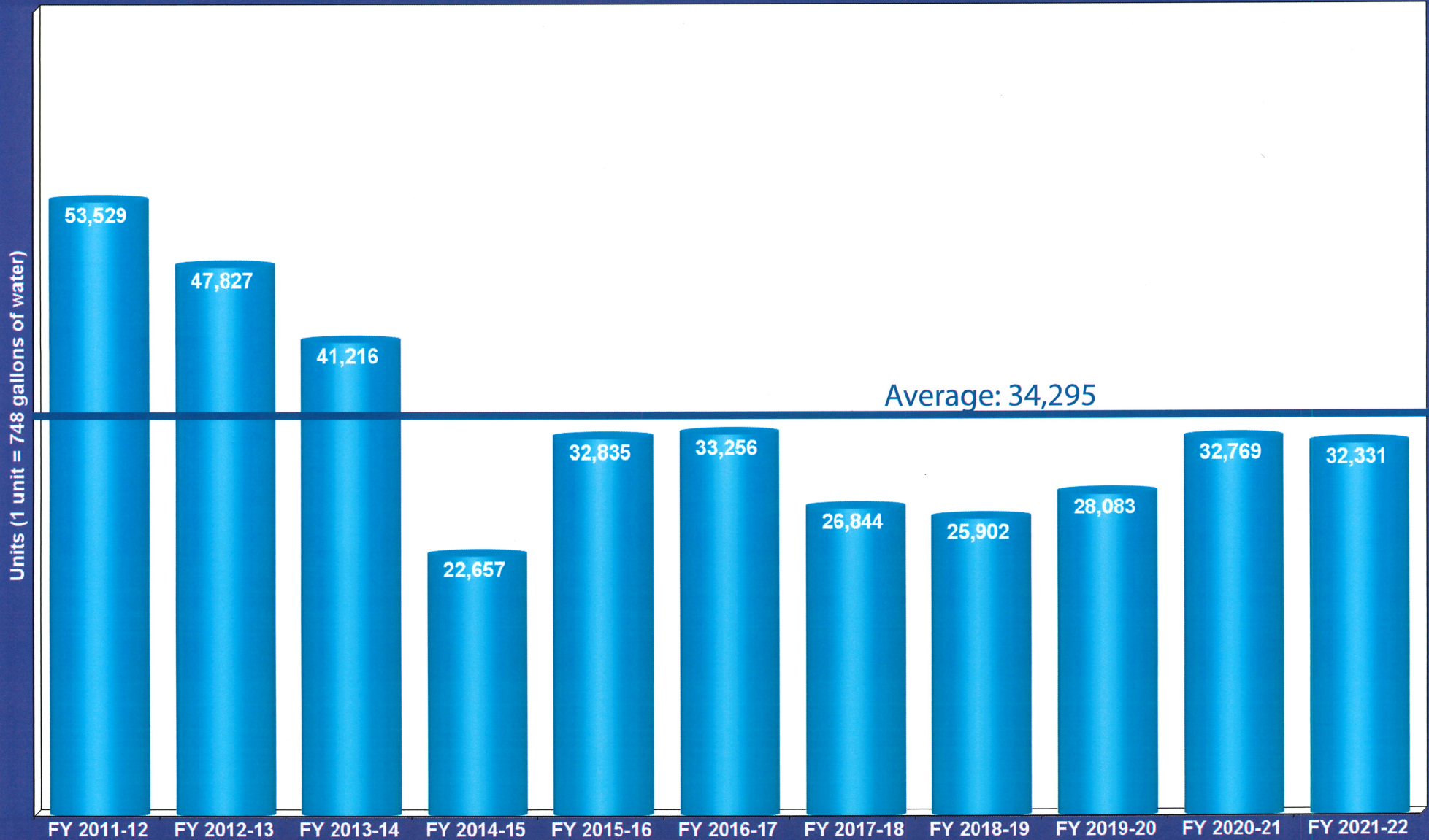
CONEJO RECREATION AND PARK DISTRICT WATER USAGE PER ACRE (ALL FUNDS)

Actual as of 7/1/2022

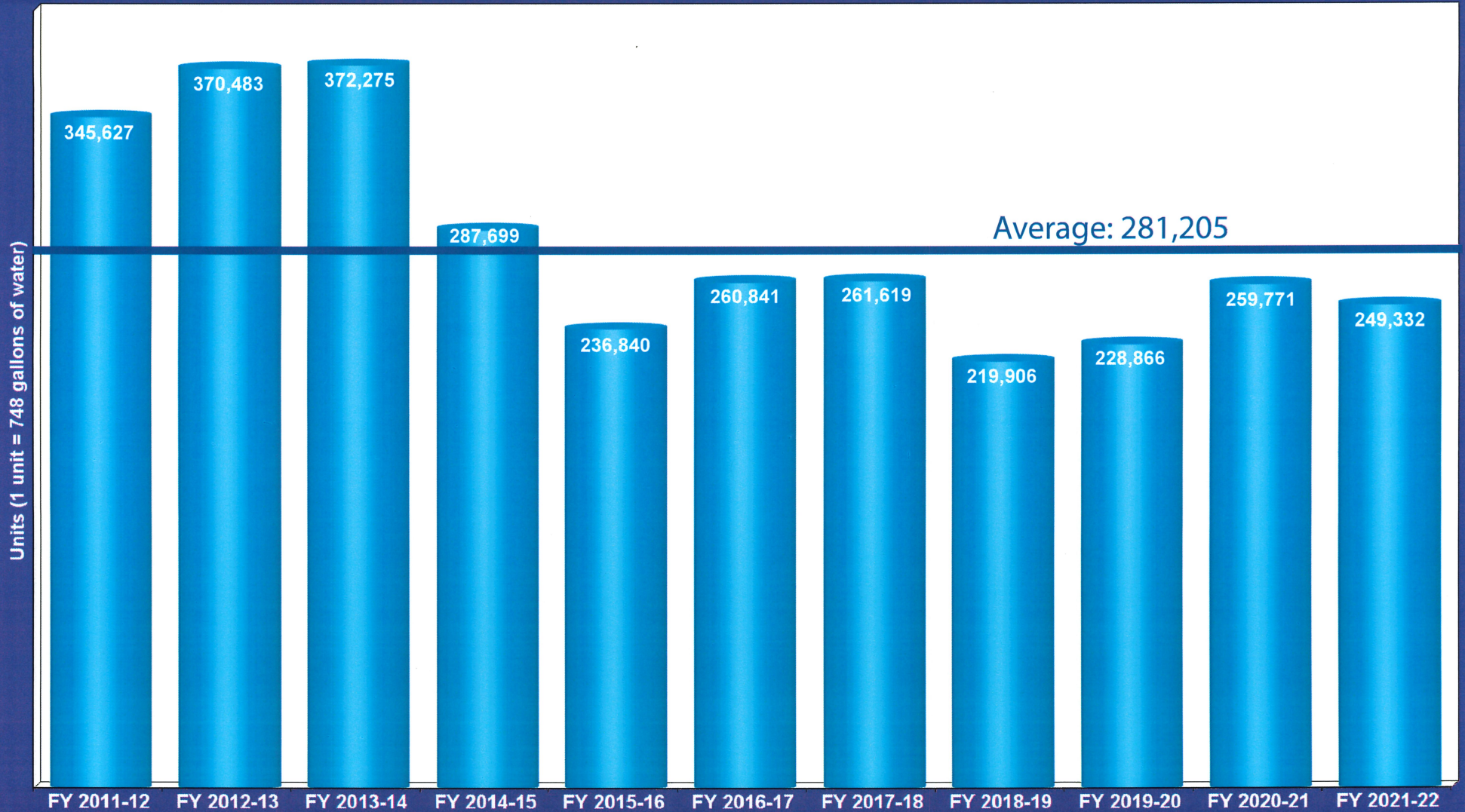

Historical Water Usage for June

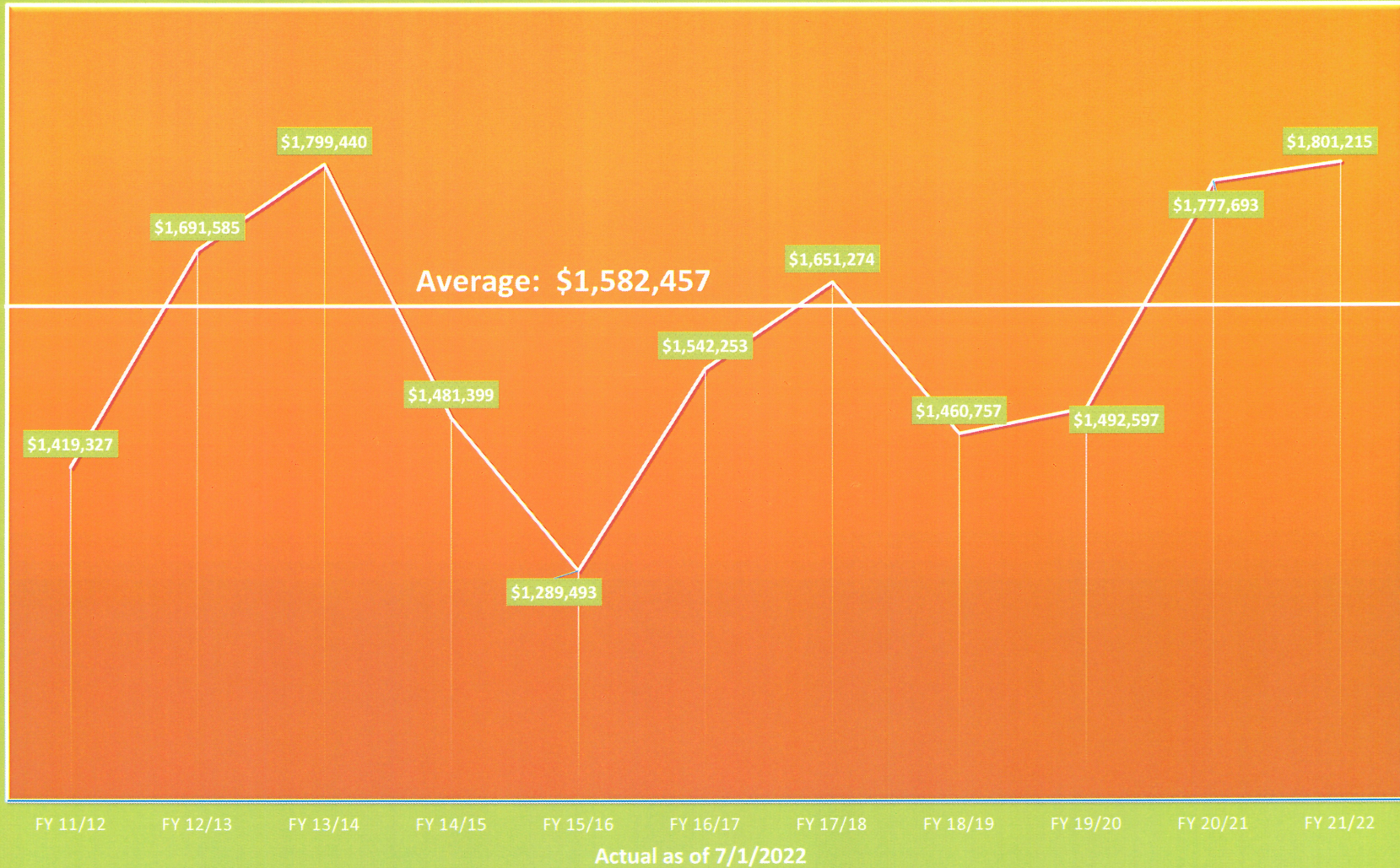
